- -Mr. Price is aware of the bus issues and has been in touch with CMS Transportation to make them aware of the continued problem of buses running late, or not showing up at all. He suggests that parents also keep calling CMS Transportation to commincate their frustrations and concerns until the matter is corrected.
- -New 5th Grade teacher will rotate in the 5th Grade classes to help with the large class size.
- -Pam Jones has been hired as the Financial Secretary.
- -June 3rd is the projected date to vote on lowering classroom sizes to 16 students per class. If it passes it would mean mobile unites would have to be brought in and in some districts it could mean the possibility of eliminating specials.
- -Teacher allotments are deteremined mid March.
